V. Questions & Comments

Q: If other states are using opioid settlement money for certain activities, does that mean that MD can use ORF funds for the same activities?

A: Not necessarily. A lawyer would need to review to ensure alignment with MD statute.

Q: Buprenorphine was mentioned, are there efforts to also increase access to methadone?

A: Yes. All evidence-based treatments for OUD are supported.

Q: Will the recommendations memo be made available publicly? If so, when?

A: Yes. It will be posted on the OCCC's website at the same time it's submitted to the Governor and Secretary of Health.

Comment: Gratitude for including funding for naloxone as a recommendation.

Comment: More needs to be done to ensure that individuals being released from incarceration have access to MOUD in the community.

Comment: Need to be able to hire staff with funding.
