Overview of Mallinckrodt Settlement and Mandate

To meet the requirements of the Mallinckrodt Plan, a subcommittee of the ORF advisory council was created. The role of this subcommittee is to make recommendations on the distribution of the Mallinckrodt funds.

The Trust Distribution Procedures designated Anne Arundel County, Baltimore City, Baltimore County, Montgomery County, and Prince George's County as qualifying block grantees. The Committee's first order of business was to discuss the designation of regions from among the counties that were not designated as qualifying block grantees by the Trust Distribution Procedures.

<u>Remaining counties</u>: Allegany, Calvert, Caroline, Carroll, Cecil, Charles, Dorchester, Frederick, Garrett, Harford, Howard, Kent, Queen Anne's, Somerset, St. Mary's, Talbot, Washington, Wicomico, Worcester
