I. Welcome & Introductions

- Laura Mitchell asked if lockbox restrictions have been considered for the ORF to prevent funds from being used other than intended, noting past instances where funds were used for other necessary programs. Emily Keller affirmed that state statute includes safeguards to prevent supplanting and mentioned that their office has developed productive relationships with DBM and other departments to stress the importance of utilizing the ORF for its intended purpose.
